

## Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Alabama With Opioid Settlement Fund

### Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

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Healthcare organizations in Alabama can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Alabama State Legislature, <https://mh.alabama.gov/opioid-settlement/>.

Here's how:

- 1. State Share:** Directly appropriated by the state legislature based on recommendations from the Oversight Commission on Alabama Opioid Settlement Funds and the Opioid Overdose and Addiction Council. <https://mh.alabama.gov/faq/alabama-opioid-overdose-and-addiction-council/>. Grants are awarded via an RFP submission process for proposals that prevent, reduce, treat, or mitigate the effects of opioid use. Awards are determined by a Selection Committee comprised of professionals with prevention, treatment, and recovery backgrounds from multidisciplinary teams, community leaders, and state agency personnel. Committee members can't submit a proposal or be employed by an agency that submitted a proposal.
- 2. Local Share:** Determined by local municipality, county, and governmental public health entity (e.g., public hospital, county health department, board of health) officials.
