

## Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Alaska With Opioid Settlement Fund

### Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

---

Healthcare organizations in Alaska can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Alaska Division of Public Health (DPH), <https://health.alaska.gov/en/education/drugs-and-alcohol/opioids-prevention-and-recovery/opioid-settlement/>.

Here's how:

- 1. State Share:** Appropriated by the state legislature to DPH for distribution based on recommendations and guidance from the Governor's Advisory Council on Opioid Remediation (GACOR) and the Opioid Settlement Steering Committee. Multi-year grants are awarded via a competitive RFP process by a committee with representatives from DPH, the Division of Behavioral Health, State of Alaska procurement, and the Alaska Mental Health Trust. There is a maximum of 3 grantees from each of the 7 Public Health Regions plus one additional statewide grantee per RFP award.
- 2. Local Share:** Determined by local borough and city officials.
