



Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Alaska With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Alaska can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Alaska Division of Public Health (DPH), <https://health.alaska.gov/en/education/drugs-and-alcohol/opioids-prevention-and-recovery/opioid-settlement/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Appropriated by the state legislature to DPH for distribution based on recommendations and guidance from the Governor's Advisory Council on Opioid Remediation (GACOR) and the Opioid Settlement Steering Committee. Multi-year grants are awarded via a competitive RFP process by a committee with representatives from DPH, the Division of Behavioral Health, State of Alaska procurement, and the Alaska Mental Health Trust. There is a maximum of 3 grantees from each of the 7 Public Health Regions plus one additional statewide grantee per RFP award.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local borough and city officials.
