

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Arizona With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Arizona can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Arizona Attorney General (AG), <https://www.azag.gov/issues/opioids>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Appropriated by the state legislature and awarded as grants through the AG's office, <https://www.azag.gov/procurement>.
2. **Local Share:** Participating local governments determine the fund distribution process with the county health department serving as the lead agency for single county regions and an advisory council governing multicounty regions. Counties determine whether they want to be designated as a single region or want to combine with one or more other counties to function as multicounty regions.
