

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Colorado With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Colorado can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Colorado Attorney General's Office (AG) and the Colorado Opioid Abatement Council (COAC), <https://geoinfo.coag.gov/portal/apps/sites/#!/settlement-distributions>.

Here's how:

1. **State share:** Grant applications via the AG's Funding Opportunities website <https://coag.gov/funding-opportunities/>. Approved by the AG with recommendations from the Opioid Crisis Recovery Funds Advisory Committee.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials.
3. **Regional Share:** Regional Opioid Abatement Councils develop 2-year spending plans which the Colorado Opioid Abatement Council (COAC) determines comply with authorized use. Each region decides the allocation process.
4. **Infrastructure Share:** The COAC lists funding opportunities and decides on those applications.
