

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Delaware With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Delaware can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Delaware Behavioral Health Consortium (BHC), <https://deopioidsettlementfunds.org/>.

Here's how:

1. The BHC distributes funds based on recommendations from the Prescription Opioid Settlement Distribution Commission (POSDC). The POSDC is an established committee of the BHC. Grant applications are reviewed by part of the POSDC along with a community review panel before the full POSDC decides.
2. There are three tiers of grants:
 - a. Micro grants - up to \$10k for short-term, immediate-impact projects
 - b. Mini grants - between \$10k - \$30k for structured medium-term projects
 - c. General grants - over \$30k for large-scale projects with detailed plans.
