Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Florida can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Florida State Legislature, <https://floridaopioidsettlement.com/overview/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Appropriated by the state legislation based on recommendations from the Statewide Council on Opioid Abatement (SCOA) within the Department of Children and Families.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials.
3. **Regional Share:** Determined by local officials of qualified counties or by managing entities for non-qualified counties.
