



Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Georgia With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Georgia can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Georgia Opioid Crisis Abatement Trust, <https://www.gaopiodtrust.org/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Organizations respond to RFPs to apply for funding grants allocated by the Trustee of the Georgia Opioid Abatement Trust (majority of funds) with input from the Georgia Opioid Settlement Advisory Commission and the Regional Advisory Councils. Cobb, DeKalb, Fulton, and Gwinnett Counties and the city of Atlanta independently determine how to spend the remaining portion of regional funds.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials with guidance from their Regional Advisory Councils.
