

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Idaho With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Idaho can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Idaho State Legislature and Governor, <https://www.ag.idaho.gov/consumer-protection/opioid-settlement/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Idaho Behavioral Health Council (IBHC) submits funding priorities to the governor for inclusion in the state budget process. The Governor's Office and the Division of Financial Management work with state agencies to determine which recommendations appear in the Governor's budget. The state legislature has final approval authority.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials but must be included in budget or via a separate passed resolution authorizing the expenditure from the opioid settlement funds.
3. **Health District Share:** Determined by each Public Health District's Board of Health but expenditures must be included in the budget or as separate resolutions. Uses must be reported to the State.
