Healthcare organizations in Illinois can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Governor's Opioid Overdose Prevention and Recovery Steering Committee, <https://www.ilopioidsettlements.com/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** At the State's discretion.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county, city, and other municipality officials.
3. **Opioid Remediation Trust Fund Share:** Decided by the Governor's Opioid Overdose Prevention and Recovery Steering Committee, [IDHS: Governor's Opioid Prevention and Recovery Steering Committee](#), based on recommendations from the Illinois Opioid Remediation Advisory Board (IORAB). IORAB recommendations are approved by the Steering Committee and allocated by the Department of Human Services.
