Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Indiana can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) Division of Mental Health and Addiction, <https://www.in.gov/recovery/settlement/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** FSSA submits a spending plan for 35% of the funds to the state's Budget Committee for approval. The remaining 15% is directly appropriated by the General Assembly.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local town, city, and county officials.
