Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Kansas can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Kansas Fights Addiction Act Grant Review Board, <https://www.ag.ks.gov/reports-resources/affiliated-organizations/kansas-fights-addiction-act-grant-review-board>.

Here's how:

- 1. State Share (Kansas Fights Addiction Fund Share):** Approved by the Kansas Fights Addiction Act Grant Review Board after consulting with the state's Prescription Drug and Opioid Advisory Committee, Department of Health and Environment, and other stakeholders. Organizations apply via RFP grant funding process [Kansas Fights Addiction - Sunflower Foundation](#). Eligibility is limited to state agencies, local and county governments and nonprofit organizations that provide services in Kansas for the purpose of preventing, reducing, treating, or otherwise abating or remediating substance abuse or addiction.
- 2. Local Share (Municipalities Fight Addiction Fund Share):** Determined by local city and county officials.
