

## Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Maryland With Opioid Settlement Fund

### Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

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Healthcare organizations in Maryland can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Maryland Department of Health (DOH), <https://stopoverdose.maryland.gov/orf/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** The DOH allocates funds based on recommendations from the Opioid Restitution Fund Advisory Council.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county, city, and town officials.
3. **Targeted Abatement Grants Share:** Determined by qualifying charter counties. Other localities must have an approved local abatement plan to receive funds from the DOH.
4. **State Discretionary Abatement Fund Share:** Allocated by the DOH through a competitive grant program based on recommendations from the Opioid Restitution Fund Advisory Council.
