Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Michigan can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), <https://www.michigan.gov/opioids/opioidsettlements>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** The state legislature appropriates funds to MDHHS based on non-binding annual funding recommendations from the Michigan Opioid Advisory Commission (OAC). MDHHS distributes funds to state agencies and other entities.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county, city, and township officials.
