

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Montana With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Montana can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Montana Opioid Abatement Trust (MOAT), <https://montanaopiod.org/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Determined by the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services and the Montana Department of Justice.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials.
3. **Montana Opioid Abatement Trust Share:** Abatement Regions and local governments decide 80% of this share and submit proposals to the Montana Opioid Abatement Trust's Advisory Committee. The Advisory Committee is required to distribute the funds if the proposal is for approved purposes. The Advisory Committee determines how much of the remaining 20% to spend on statewide programs, innovation, research, and education.
