

## Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in New York With Opioid Settlement Fund

### Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

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Healthcare organizations in New York can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports (OASAS), <https://oasas.ny.gov/opioid-settlement-fund>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** The Attorney General decides and may opt to direct funds to localities.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county and New York City officials.
3. **Opioid Settlement Fund Share:** Appropriated by the NY State Legislature to OASAS for disbursement. The Opioid Settlement Fund Advisory Board, <https://oasas.ny.gov/opioid-settlement-fund-advisory-board>, makes non-binding expenditure recommendations to the legislature, OASAS, other state agencies, and local governments.
