Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in North Carolina can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the North Carolina General Assembly, <https://www.ncleg.gov/>, and Local Governments.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Appropriated by the North Carolina General Assembly for statewide opioid abatement projects.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county and municipality officials, [North Carolina Opioid Settlements](#), but must be codified as an authorized budget expenditure or in a separate funding resolution.
