

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Oklahoma With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Oklahoma can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board, <https://oklahoma.gov/oag/resources/meetings/opioid-abatement-board.html>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** The Legislature appropriates funds directly to state agencies and departments.
2. **Local Share (Litigating Subdivision District Share):** Determined by local city and county officials.
3. **Opioid Abatement Board Share:** The Legislature appropriates funds to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Revolving Fund which are distributed by the Opioid Abatement Board which falls under the Attorney General's office. Grants are awarded to political subdivisions based on a formula that includes the number of people with OUD, the number of overdose deaths, and the amount of opioids distributed within that subdivision.

* Percentage split between Shares varies per settlement. For example, the split from the Distributors settlement is 75% State and 25% Local but the Allergan settlement split is 25% State and 75% Local while neither shows the Other Share going to the Opioid Abatement Board.
