Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Pennsylvania can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Pennsylvania Opioid Misuse and Addiction Abatement Trust (the Trust), <https://www.paopioidtrust.org/>.

Here's how:

The Trust receives opioid settlement funds and distributes them to the Commonwealth and participating counties and subdivisions for exclusive use on opioid abatement. Fund allocation decisions:

1. **State Share:** Funds are appropriated by the Pennsylvania General Assembly.
2. **Local Share (County):** Determined by county officials.
3. **Local Share (Litigating Subdivisions):** Determined by local officials for each county, city, township, and borough along with the District Attorneys for Berks, Bucks, Chester, Clearfield, Dauphin, Delaware, Erie, Northampton, and Westmoreland counties.
