Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Rhode Island can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS), <https://eohhs.ri.gov/>.

Here's how:

- 1. State Share:** The Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee (OSAC), eohhs.ri.gov/Opioid-Settlement-Advisory-Committee, submits expenditure recommendations and associated budgets to the Secretary of EOHHS for alignment and inclusion in EOHHS' final budget submission to the Governor. The Governor determines items included in the budget submitted to the General Assembly for approval. Approved funding is appropriated to EOHHS to award funding to applicants through the bidding/solicitation process, <https://preventoverdoseri.org/funding-announcements/>.
- 2. Local Share:** Determined by local city and town officials.
