

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Tennessee With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Tennessee can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Tennessee Opioid Abatement Council, <https://www.tn.gov/oac.html>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Allocated by the General Assembly.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county and municipal officials.
3. **Opioid Abatement Fund Share:** Determined by the Tennessee Opioid Abatement Council. 65% of the total share is allocated for Community Funding based on the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services' needs assessment and in consideration of public stakeholder comments. The remaining 35% of this share is allocated to counties for Council-approved programs.
