

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Texas With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Texas can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council (OAFC) which is part of the Texas Comptroller's Office, <https://comptroller.texas.gov/programs/opioid-council/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Determined by the Texas Legislature.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county and municipality officials.
3. **Opioid Abatement Trust Fund:** Determined by OAFC except for certain set-asides established by the state Legislature. Regional Healthcare Partnership Regions apply for grant funding which is allocated based on regional share.
