Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Vermont can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Vermont Department of Health (DOH), <https://www.healthvermont.gov/alcohol-drugs/public-meetings-comments/opioid-settlement-advisory-committee>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Determined by "the State" which is not defined.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county, city, and town officials.
3. **Opioid Abatement Fund Share:** Appropriated by the state legislature based on recommendations from the DOH and its Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee.
