

Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in Virginia With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in Virginia can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by Virginia Opioid Abatement Authority (OAA), <https://www.oaa.virginia.gov/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Appropriated by the General Assembly.
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local city and county officials.
3. **Opioid Abatement Fund Share:** The OAA allocates 85% of this share's funds in accordance with state law and the state's MOU as follows:
 - 15% to state agencies
 - 33% to Regional Efforts/Cooperative Partnerships
 - 35% to 'unrestricted' usesLocalities decide how to spend their 15% portion of this share but must adhere to OAA rules and monitoring.
