Healthcare organizations in Washington can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the Washington State Health Care Authority and the State Opioid Coordinator, [Washington State Opioid Settlements | Healthier Washington Collaboration Portal](#).

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Appropriated by the Washington state legislature based on recommendations from the State Opioid and Overdose Response (SOOR) plan workgroup, SOOR plan executive sponsors, and the Governor's office, [State Opioid and Overdose Response \(SOOR\) plan | Washington State Health Care Authority](#).
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county, city, and town officials subject to oversight by Regional Opioid Abatement Councils.
