



Leverage Sustainable SUD Funding in West Virginia With Opioid Settlement Fund

Opioid Settlement Fund Offers Opportunity to Secure Sustainable Funding for Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment

Healthcare organizations in West Virginia can now access additional behavioral healthcare funding as part of the Opioid Settlement Fund administered by the West Virginia First Foundation, <https://wvfirst.org/>.

Here's how:

1. **State Share:** Allocated by the Attorney General for opioid litigation expenses. Unspent funds by December 31, 2026, are reallocated to the Local Share (1%) and Foundation Share (2%).
2. **Local Share:** Determined by local county, city, town, and village officials.
3. **Foundation Share:** The West Virginia First Foundation, a private nonprofit, Board of Directors determines distribution of 80% of this share's funds via grant programs. The remaining 20% of this fund's share is determined by the six regions with input from local governments.
